Description: Nyam Nyam will facilitate a workshop resulting on a showing of the performative installation of their work “8000 years later”. The workshop will treat the topic of agriculture as a turning point in the course of humanity and work towards a speculative vision of the present and the future. Nyam Nyam will adapt their installation for the CCN, collecting objects, texts, memory of the place ending in a showing as a performative installation.

The workshop gathers students and artists from Montpellier Fine arts school and Exerce MA and artists from the Life Long Burning network.

Nyam Nyam is a group created in 2012 the artists Inaki Alvarez and Adriana Rodriguez at the crossroad of performance / visual arts / critic analysis / pedagogy / social interactions.
